NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

As part of the Lower Peninsula Stormwater Improvements Southeast Regional System Project, **the City of Tampa is expanding its plan to replace the water transmission line on West Bay Avenue between South Himes Avenue and South Sterling Avenue. The water transmission line will be extended an additional block to South Dale Mabry Highway. During this work, the westbound travel lane of West Bay Avenue between South Himes Avenue and South Dale Mabry Highway will be closed Monday through Friday between 7:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., with occasional Saturdays as needed, beginning in April 2024 and continuing until May 2024, weather permitting.** As construction progresses westward on West Bay Avenue, driveways and intersections will become inaccessible during daytime work hours. Nearby on-street parking will be available and pedestrian access to homes will be maintained. Residents with concerns about ADA accessibility or other special circumstances can call (813) 642-3595 to discuss the issue with the project management team. Thank you for your patience during the temporary disruption while this important project moves forward.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING CONSTRUCTION

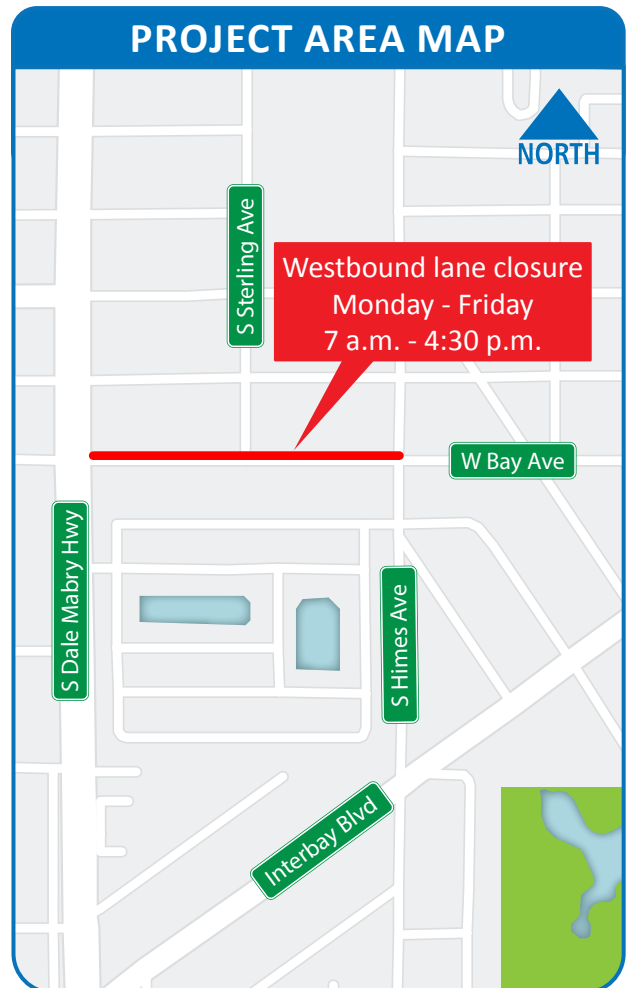
Residents will be notified in advance of any anticipated utility service disruptions. Members of the construction team will assist with trash removal and package delivery. As construction continues, the City of Tampa reminds residents and commuters to exercise caution when traveling through construction areas.

PROJECT OVERVIEW

In 2016, the City of Tampa approved a Stormwater Improvement Assessment which established funding for much needed capital improvement projects aimed at alleviating flooding and improving water quality within the City's Stormwater improvement area. The Lower Peninsula Stormwater Improvements Southeast Regional System Project is the first of several projects that have been identified in the City's Lower Peninsula Watershed Management Plan.

PROJECT GOAL

This project will alleviate long-standing flooding conditions within the Southeast region of the City's Lower Peninsula and provide water quality improvements, including removal of trash, oils, greases, and nutrients from stormwater discharges to Hillsborough Bay.
